# Problem (7)

#### High startup failure and youth unemployment

The National Bureau of statistics report of Sep 2016 revealed that 13.5 million youth of employable age are currently unemployable due to lack of needed skills. Some of the reasons include inconsistency of government policies, lack of right skill sets, insufficient access to funding, high cost of registering business. However, 83% of youths we surveyed had no prior knowledge about innovations and design thinking. Hence, even the skillful youths cannot adapt their skills to solve huge societal problem in the country. Besides, 61.07% of start-ups fail in Nigeria, highest failure rate among top 3 biggest tech ecosystem and investment destination in sub Saharan Africa




**Yusuf Babatunde** is a co-founder of the innovation and design thinking academy (TIDA), and the chief operations officer (COO).

After serving a 2-months internship at Zohay Healthcare and a 3-months internship at Robotics and Artificial Intelligence Nigeria (R.AI.N), Yusuf proceeded to lead a team to build a multi-lingual chatbot that can diagnose specific mental health conditions and also provide psychoeducation for youths in Tanzania.

His team has won several innovation completion including; 2022 PrEP4youth innovation challenge, 2021 Hults Prize On-campus Winner, 2021 winner of the VOICE open call for HIV consent research. His team was also a finalist at the first Nigerian Science and Technology Innovation Competition (STIC) in 2021, semi-finalist at Ignite Africa in 2020, three (3) times regional finalist at Hults Prize in Abuja and Nairobi.

Currently, Yusuf and his team are in the first testing phase of "Frigo", an off-grid cooling system built to reduce post-harvesting food spoilage among market men and women in Nigeria after they received a funding of \$1,000 to build a mini-prototype. He is also enrolled at the startup school with Ycombinator to further his knowledge on successfully building a sustainable startup in Africa.
